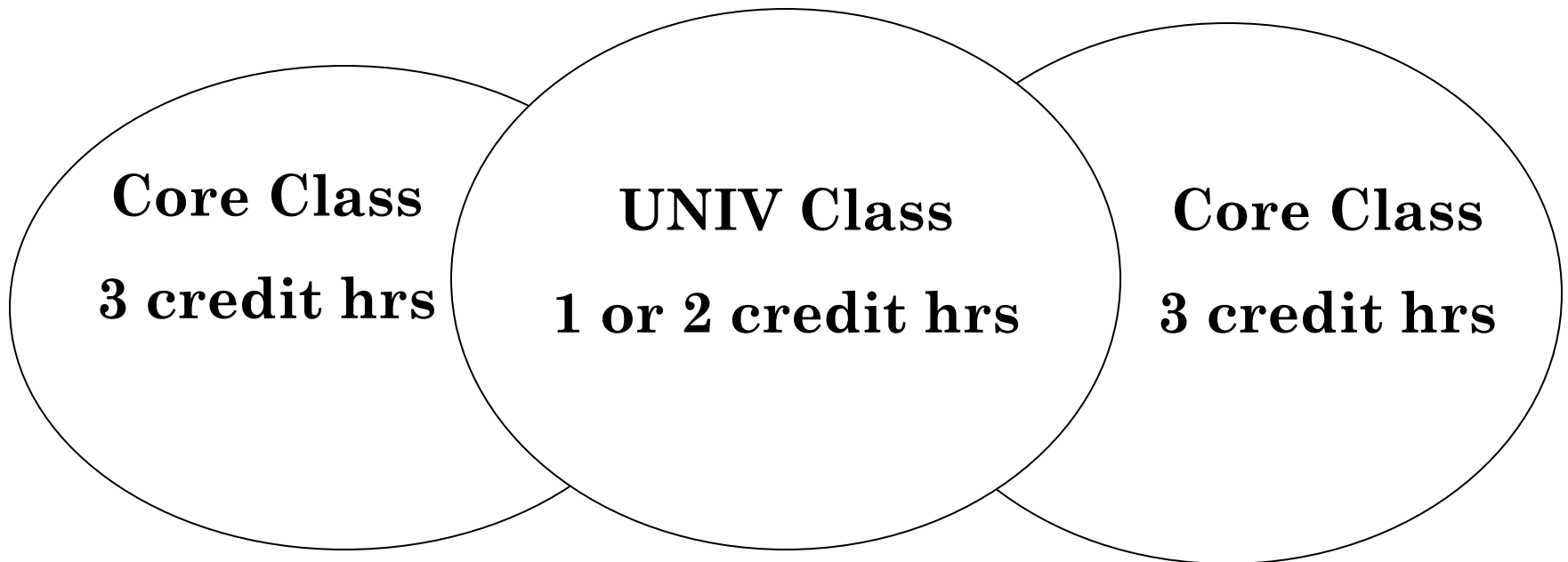
# What are Learning Communities all about?

- Freshman year program only
- Communities of 25 students
- Based on college or theme
- Co-registered for core classes with LC
- Can elect to do residential option prior to April 1 deadline
- Additional opportunities but not required



# Learning Community Classes

- **Pre-registered** for core classes
- UNIV freshman seminar class
- Student chooses remaining classes to fill out schedule



# Popular Questions

- What if I have AP/IB/Dual Enrollment credit for a learning community class?
  - Must remain in UNIV class and at least 1 other LC class to stay in learning community
- What if I change my major?
  - Can change in spring but recommend stay in – core classes so same regardless of major and already connected to group
- What if I'm in the Honors College?
  - No problem! Just remember LC classes won't be honors sections. You will need to register for honors classes on your own

# Residential Option

- **Must be guaranteed housing first – complete housing application by deadline**
- Residence halls located close to LC classes
- Take UNIV classes in residence halls
- Live close to other students in classes



# Popular Question

- Will my roommate be in my learning community?
  - If you indicated on your LC application that you wanted to live with your LC AND you are guaranteed housing, you have been assigned to live in a learning community residence hall
  - Your room mate will be in A learning community... not necessarily the same one as you
- What housing preferences should I list on my housing application?
  - Fill out your housing application as if you aren't going to live with your learning community.
  - When you sign up to live with our program that overrides the preferences listed on your housing application.

# What are the benefits?

- Core support group to help with transition
- Pre-registered for several fall and spring classes
- Opportunity to get to know LC Coordinator who will be a faculty member or administrator in students' college/school or interdisciplinary interest
- Opportunity to get to know your peer instructor (successful upperclassman who can help students better connect to Auburn)
- Program assessment has shown that a higher % of LC students are in good academic standing at the end of their freshmen year compared to entire freshmen class

- ✓ Learning Community application will be available online at: [www.auburn.edu/lc](http://www.auburn.edu/lc) in early February
- ✓ You will be notified before coming to Camp War Eagle of which LC you are in
